

- **STATIC GROUPS:** Students in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and below will remain in the same classroom throughout the school day with the same group of students. Efforts will be made to limit movement of students in 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade.
- **ROUTINE CLEANING:** Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned multiple times throughout the school day. When students change classrooms, shared surface spaces will be sanitized. JCCS has contracted a professional cleaning company to clean all buildings at the conclusion of each school day. JCCS has treated all buildings with a fogging/misting process that kills 99.99% of harmful microbes and protects all surfaces for 90 days. This treatment will be repeated before the start of school and throughout the year.
- **LUNCH:** Students will eat lunch in the classroom or outside. School lunch will be delivered to classrooms or served in a grab-and-go format. Our preference is that students bring their own lunch from home.
- **LIMITING OF LARGE GATHERINGS:** Gatherings will be limited to the maximum group size allowed during the current phase. Class changes will be staggered to decrease the number of students in hallways at one time. Arrival and dismissal procedures will be modified to maintain physical distancing.
- **LIMITING VISITORS:** Nonessential visitors, including parents, will not be allowed in the school building. Parents must call the office so that the staff can assist them with their need.
- **VENTILATION:** Circulation of outdoor air will be increased when possible through opening windows and ventilation systems.
- **WATER:** Students will be allowed to bring their own water bottle to school each day (labeled with the student's name) to eliminate the use of shared water fountains.
- **BUS TRANSPORTATION:** There will be no bus transportation during phase 1. Buses will operate at 50 percent of their normal capacity during Phase 2, and 75 percent of their normal capacity during Phase 3, with appropriate spacing. This may require double routes, staggered arrival and dismissal times, and limited availability for bus transportation.
- **BEFORE / AFTER CARE:** JCCS will only offer before/ after care for lower school students during phases 2 and 3. Due to the maximum group size requirements, space will be limited and your child's spot for the semester must be reserved prior to August 17. A before/after care registration form will be emailed this summer.
- In the event that a student or staff member contracts COVID-19, that individual will not be allowed to return to school until they have met CDC's criteria to discontinue home isolation. The student will transition to at-home online learning during that time. JCCS will consult with health and safety officials to determine any additional steps that need to be taken, such as the need for other individuals to quarantine or the need to transition a specific group of students, faculty, or the entire school to at-home learning for a period of time.
